

#### BOONE COUNTY, NEBRASKA

(Boone Co) lies in middle east of the state. Population is 8,683. Albion is the county seat. Topography is rolling and along the streams winding in broad valleys, the soil is entirely fertile. The soil in proportion, has some prairie and quite a bit of sand in parts. The water level is 25 to 75 feet deep. Czechs in the county are rare; only four families live near postoffice of Closter and three near town of Albion. In the southeast part: we find an inhabitant by death (inherited), Jos. Dolezal on 640 acres. I do not know at the present time, where everyone lives on legal property with regards to inheritance and can't find out. Mr. J. Simerda, at the present time living in California, is a land surveyor and sells land here and no doubt, there will be other nationals (Czechs) coming here.

### PLATTE COUNTY, NEBRASKA

(Platte Co) lies mid-east section of the state. Population is 15,425. Platte Center is county seat. Columbus, one of the larger towns in the state, is the commercial center on the railroad. Topography is gently rolling prairie, here and there slope erodes violently. Soil is entirely productive. The land value is \$18.00 to \$25.00 per acre. Certainly the nearness of Columbus is worth the higher fee. In and around Platte Center, to the west, we find a settlement of Polish. The Czechs are mostly around Lindsay.
