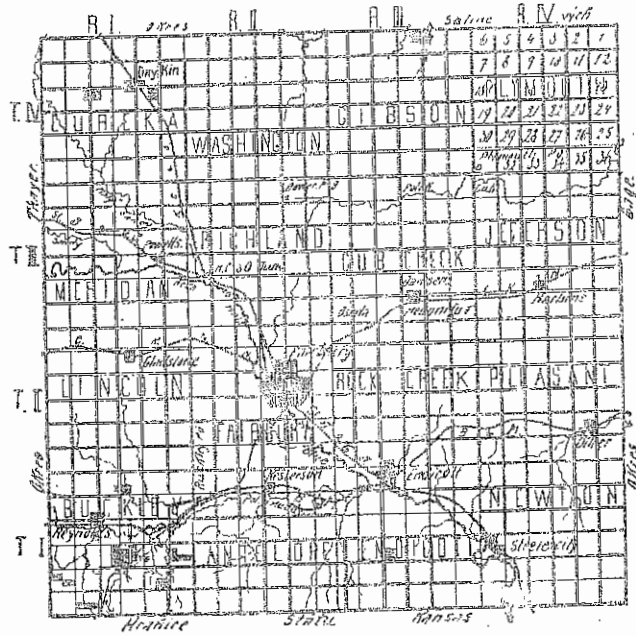

JEFFERSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA

(Jefferson County) lies east of the sixth meridian near the Kansas border. It has 14,825 inhabitants. Fairbury is the county seat. Topography is rolling prairie in the north part. Other ground is gravelly and in many places greatly sloping. The soil that is not rocky or intersperced with gravel is fertile. The Czech community is in the southwest part and was founded in the year 1869 by Frant. Zavodsky, who came on horseback. In time more countrymen arrived and settled mostly among their own.
